ANNEX A: INDIVIDUAL CADET KIT LIST

1. Cadets are required to bring the following:
 - a. Full uniform (C2);
 - b. Cadet issued parka and liner, without ranks;
 - c. Parade boots;
 - d. Wool socks;
 - e. Undergarments;
 - f. Toiletries;
 - g. Appropriate civilian attire for the two travel days, which should require no more than one pair of jeans (in good repair) for the two days plus two shirts;
 - h. Warm socks;
 - i. Running shoes;
 - j. Sleeping attire;
 - k. Chapstick;
 - l. Personal spending money;
 - m. Health card;
 - n. Passport; and
 - o. Completed parental consent waiver.
2. Cadets **MAY** bring personal electronics such as digital cameras and music players (with headphones) but these are discouraged and are brought entirely at the cadet's own risk. Neither the trip staff nor the squadron will be responsible should such items go missing.

3. Cadets are **NOT** to bring the following:
 - a. Alcohol;
 - b. Non-prescription drugs;
 - c. Knives; or
 - d. Cigarettes or cigars.

There is minimal space for luggage on this trip. Cadets should pack to fit everything except parkas and liners into a suitcase 22cm x 35cm x 56cm (9" x 14" x 22"). Parkas and liners should be labelled with the cadet's name.

Any and all prescription medication will be turned in to the OIC upon arrival to the LHQ on Sunday, 15 March 2015. Health cards and parental consent waivers will be collected upon arrival and carried by the syndicate leaders for the duration of the trip. Passports will be verified upon arrival and will be collected by the syndicate leaders after clearing US Immigration.

No smoking of any kind, or consumption of alcohol or unprescribed drugs be tolerated on this trip. Any cadet caught in possession of any of the above items or otherwise creating a significant disciplinary problem will be returned home immediately at the expense of his or her parents or guardians.
