INTER-FLIGHT COMPETITIONS



1. The purpose of the Inter-Flight Competition (IFC) is to allow the cadets to engage in a healthy competitive atmosphere that will increase esprit de corps within 809 Squadron. The IFC will also allow Flight Commanders to put into practice the leadership techniques they have learned as well as learn new methods of management and motivation.
2. The competition will consist of “events”, which will be worth a certain number of points. The flight with the most points at the end of the current training year will be awarded the Top Flight Award. The following events will make up the IFC:

EVENT	WEIGHT
Attendance	30%
Uniform Inspection	20%
Sports Competition	15%
Drill Competition	15%
Cadet of the Night	10%
Squadron Effective Speaking Competition	10%
TOTAL	100%

ATTENDANCE

3. Attendance will be taken on parade each evening as directed by the Commanding Officer. Attendance will be marked as an average of the total number of cadets in the flight, *including the flight commander*. At the end of the training year the monthly attendance averages will be averaged for the last time, which will give the Flight Yearly Attendance Average.

UNIFORM INSPECTION

4. Uniforms will be inspected every Wednesday evening upon arrival. All completed forms are to be submitted to the Training Officer to be included in the cadet's trg file. In addition, all flights will be inspected immediately before they compete in the Drill Competition.

SPORTS COMPETITION

5. The Sports Competition will be held in **JANUARY 2018**. A tally will be kept of the number of games each flight wins and ties. The flight will receive 2 points for a win and 1 point for a tie. The points will then be added from all the games played and a mark assigned for the flights performance during the competition. The flight with the most points will be the overall winner.

DRILL COMPETITION

6. The Drill Competition will be held in **MAY 2017**. All members of the flight will be a part of the Flight Drill Team. The Flight Commander will be the Drill Team Commander. Uniforms will be inspected to the side of the parade square while the previous team is performing the drill sequence.

CADET OF THE NIGHT

7. Each cadet training night, one cadet will be chosen as the cadet of the night based on their drill, dress and deportment. They will be given a lanyard to be worn on their uniform the following training night. Each time a flight has the cadet-of-the-night in their flight, they will receive one point. These will be tallied over the course of the training year and added to the flight total. It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure their name is recorded.

SQUADRON EFFECTIVE SPEAKING COMPETITION

8. Each cadet that participates in the Squadron Effective Speaking Competition will receive five points for their flight. These points will be tallied and the percentage out of ten used to fill the final criteria for the inter-flight competition.
